Sprint Nextel Corporation ("Sprint Nextel") is writing to inform you of a recent security breach that affects you. A customer logged in through the CheckFree service on the Wells Fargo banking website and, when they clicked on the link to see their current Sprint invoice, they were erroneously presented with your invoice instead. The customer called to report this to Sprint immediately. This issue was caused by a system coding error that mixed up two invoices when two customers were on the system at the same time with the same billing cycle. This system error was promptly corrected to prevent any future mix-ups. The information that was displayed in error to the other Sprint customer was the information on your monthly invoice, including your call detail information, address, Sprint wireless number and account number. No billing or other sensitive information was disclosed.

We apologize for this error. Again, it has been corrected. We do recommend that you establish and frequently change the password on your Sprint Nextel account to protect yourself from unauthorized activity in general.
